The Irwin County Board of Commissioners had its monthly meeting on September 06, 2022. The meeting was held at the Courthouse Annex; at the meeting were Chairman Scott Carver, Commissioner Aldene Tyson, Commissioner Jimmy Mobley, Commissioner Chris Paulk, Lynn Hall, Marc Mathis, Don Hickey, Red Cross Staff and County Clerk Patricia Battle.

The meeting was called to order at 8:30a.m. Commissioner Chris Paulk said the prayer, and everyone pledged the flag.

Commissioner Tyson made a motion to approve the agenda. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. Commissioner Mobley, Commissioner Tyson and Commissioner Paulk were in favor. Motion carried.

No minutes to approve at this time.

Chairman Carver explained that Joseph Collins is not qualified to be Chief Appraiser currently, but there will be stipulations for him to get his qualifications to become Chief Appraiser.

Commissioner Tyson made a motion to approve the hiring of Joseph Collins as Chief Appraiser. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. Commissioner Tyson, Commissioner Paulk and Commissioner Mobley were in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Mobley made a motion to table the discussion on retirement. Commissioner Tyson seconded the motion. Commissioner Tyson, Commissioner Mobley and Commissioner Paulk were in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Tyson made a motion to approve to go into Executive Session. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. Commissioner Tyson, Commissioner Paulk and Commissioner Mobley were in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Paulk made a motion to come out of Executive Session. Commissioner Mobley seconded the motion. Commissioner Paulk, Commissioner Mobley and Commissioner Tyson were in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Tyson made a motion to do a memorandum of understanding to set the salary for the chief appraiser with the following: (1) full salary is \$50,879.46 (2) as an Appraiser 1 starting salary will be 70% of full salary (\$35,615.62) (3) as an Appraiser 2 salary will be 80% of full salary (\$40,703.57) and (4) as an Appraiser 3 will receive full salary (\$50,879.46). Must complete by January 01, 2024 barring anything out of his control. Commissioner Mobley seconded the motion. Commissioner Tyson, Commissioner Mobley and Commissioner Paulk were all in favor. Motion carried.

Commissioner Mobley made a motion to adjourn. Commissioner Paulk seconded the motion. Commissioner Tyson, Commissioner Paulk and Commissioner Mobley were in favor. Motion carried.
